Dear Parents and Carers,

- Our Easter Egg Hunt will be taking place on the school playground and field from 2.30, if you would like to join your child in looking for the Easter clues we suggest you come in wearing wellies! The field is VERY muddy! The children will all go onto the field ready to start the hunt at 2.30pm. They will all be given a sheet to write their letters on and will have to unscramble the letters to

work out the Easter word and win themselves an Easter treat. Any child without a parent will be able to join in with their friends and staff. Once the children have found their word and earned their treat they will be able to leave school with their parents/grandparents, as long as their class teacher has been notified.

- Fir Tree parents will be invited to the school hall just before the Easter Egg Hunt to listen to the children from Fir Tree class sing their Easter song before joining them on the Easter Egg hunt. Just come along to the school hall rather than the playground when we open the gates.

Reports will be going home next week along with your child's attendance. **All attendance and lateness is tracked by the DfE.** If your child's attendance is below 90% you will be receiving a letter to bring this to your attention. If your child does have a term time holiday a penalty notice will be applied for. If your child is not in school they miss out on vital learning which can result in gaps which are very hard to fill, learning is like building blocks, if you miss out the foundation blocks it is hard to build on top of. Please support us to support your child to have the best chances for their future.

We return to school on Monday 15th April, there is NO staff development day at the beginning of term 5. The last day for clubs will be Wednesday 27th March. There will be NO clubs on Thursday 28th March.
